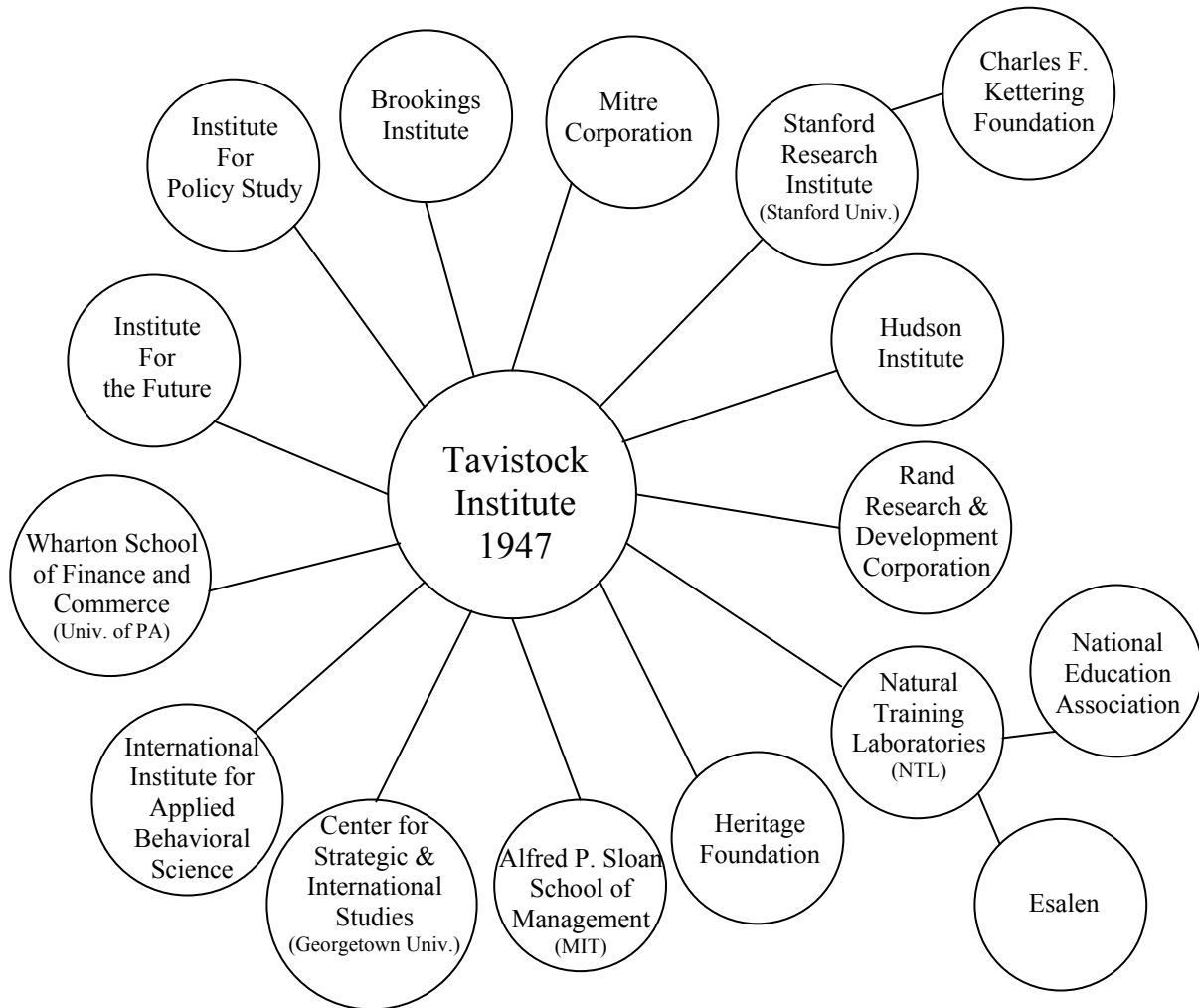

Headquartered in London, England and established in 1947, the Tavistock Institute seeks to “combine research in the social science with professional practice” along Freudian lines. The Institute set up the operational guidelines for the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) and developed mass “brainwashing” techniques used on prisoners of war (POWs) during the Korean War (1950-52). The Institute trains leaders in education, politics, and business. Today it’s a \$6 billion network organized around ten major U.S. based institutions with 400 subsidiaries and over 3,000 think tanks and study groups.
